Each parent shall have full and equal access to the postsecondary education records as provided in RCW 26.09.225. (5) The court shall not order the payment of postsecondary educational expenses beyond the child's twenty-third birthday, except for exceptional circumstances, such as mental, physical, or emotional disabilities.

RCW 26.19.090: Standards for postsecondary educational ...

The child must enroll in an accredited academic or vocational school. Additionally, they must stay in good academic standing, as defined by that institution. FERPA gives both parents, custodial and noncustodial, equal access to student information unless the school has evidence of a court order or state law revoking these rights. Applying that standard, the Court held that postsecondary institutions have a compelling interest in the benefits that flow from a diverse student body. In reaching this result, the Court followed its tradition, grounded in the First Amendment, of "giving a degree of deference to a university's academic decisions, within constitutionally prescribed limits."
